

## For Projects Less than One Acre (<1 acre projects)

- 1. The less than one acre form can be found on our website at <a href="www.northaugusta.net">www.northaugusta.net</a>. Click on Departments, select Engineering and Public Works, then Stormwater Management. Click on Construction. Then follow link to one acre form. The name of the form in the document library is: New 1 ac form.pdf
- 2. Provide 1 copy of plan (see #8 below) and application (SCDHEC less than one acre form). DO NOT submit this form to SCDHEC listed at the bottom of the form or click the "Submit by Email" button on the form. The form should be printed and mailed or hand delivered to our office.
- 3. Projects are required to provide adequate sediment and erosion controls in order to insure no offsite sedimentation into waters of the state, adjacent properties, or public right of ways.
- 4. Stormwater detention is not required for most projects. In some cases, it can be required.
- 5. A narrative description of the stormwater management and sediment control plan (drawing or sketch) is to be included. It may be written on the plan.
- 6. A general description of the adjacent property and a description of existing structures, buildings, and other fixed improvements located on surrounding properties.
- 7. A sketch or drawing of the plan including:
  - a. A site location drawing of the proposed project, indicating the location of the proposed project in relation to roadways, jurisdictional boundaries, streams and rivers.
  - b. The boundary lines of the site on which the work is to be performed.
  - c. The location of temporary and permanent vegetative and structural stormwater management and sediment control measures.
  - d. A topographic map of the site showing streams, rivers, creeks (if required). This is not required if no potential waters of the state are located near the project.
- 8. The plan is not required to be prepared by an engineer, Tier B surveyor, or landscape architect; however, if an individual with one of these licenses prepares the plan, then they must sign the plans and affix their seal.
