
Sign Retrieval

Temporary Sign Guidelines



A GUIDE TO TEMPORARY SIGNAGE IN THE CITY OF NORTH AUGUSTA

What is a Temporary Sign?

• North Augusta Development Code Section 13.4: Definitions

Temporary Sign: signs for a "temporary cause or event" that occurs only on a scheduled date or time period and for a specific purpose, regardless of whether the event is for commercial or non-commercial purposes. Examples include grand openings of new businesses, church revivals, property for sale, special events, and political campaigns. This includes sidewalk signs or A-frame signs that are moveable.

Temporary signs are the most common signs, and are those that advertise upcoming events, yard sales, real estate for sale or rent, and political campaigns. These signs are typically allowed without a permit, as long as they are placed on private property, and not in the right-of-way.

Temporary signs are limited in size depending on the use or zoning of the property where they are located. Generally, the sizes allowed are the following:

- **Residential Uses**: 6 square feet, 4 feet maximum height
- Non-Residential Uses: 16 square feet, 8 feet maximum height
- Neighborhood Commercial (NC)


 District: 6 square feet, 4 ft maximum height
- **Downtown (D) District**: 6 square feet, 4 foot maximum height

Placement of Temporary Signage

- Must be on private property, outside the right-of-way
- Outside of the sight triangle (25'x25' at intersections)


WHERE IS THE RIGHT-OF-WAY?

Below is an example of a street right-of-way. Right-of-ways vary, however, a good rule of thumb is to ensure signs are not placed directly against the road, under or beside stop signs, and behind the line of utility poles.



STREET CORNER PLACEMENT

Please place signs outside of the sight triangle (red "X")



Temporary Signs Include:

 This includes signs such as real estate for sale signs, yard sale signs, fundraiser signs, church revival signs, directional signs or any other sign not permanently affixed to the ground or permitted as any other sign type. These are examples of temporary signage:
