

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-04  
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RESTRICTION OF USE  
ON 1.44 ACRES OF CITY PROPERTY. SUCH RESTRICTION RELATED TO  
RECREATION AND IS DONE IN CONJUNCTION WITH FEDERAL FUNDING BEING  
RECEIVED BY THE CITY

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2016-15, the City requested funding through a federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant being administered by the South Carolina Department of Parks, Recreation, and Tourism; and

WHEREAS, such funding relates to a restoration project of tennis courts in a portion of Maude Edenfield Park; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded the funding as requested and is now required to place a restriction on the property where the tennis courts are located in conjunction with such funding; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is appropriate that such restrictions be placed on this portion of Maude Edenfield Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Augusta, in meeting duly assembled and by the authority thereof, that:

1. The City hereby restricts 1.44 acres of Maude Edenfield Park located in the vicinity of Brookside Avenue and East Buena Vista being a portion of Tax Map and Parcel No. 007-15-01-001, said property specifically shown on the area sketch attached hereto. The City agrees that this property may not be converted to other than public outdoor recreation uses, whether by transfer, sale, or any other manner, without the express written approval of the Secretary of the Interior.
2. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute any documents as may be necessary to impose this restriction in a manner satisfactory to the South Carolina Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism or such specific federal agency as associated with the Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant being received by the City.
