The millage for the current fiscal year (2020) is 73.5. The proposed millage rate for fiscal year 2021 is 73.5. The proposed millage rate for fiscal year 2021 will collect an estimated \$8,818,574. The proposed 2021 budget does not include a tax increase, however, the proposed 2021 budget does include a rate increase to business licenses as well as new building related permits and updated fees for planning and development. As with any budget year, there is potential for adopting millage and additional increases during the public budget hearing scheduled for October 19, 2020.
