RESOLUTION NO. 2021-02 A RESOLUTION TO REALLOCATE FUNDING FOR THE FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council previously funded and established an application process for the Façade Improvement Program via Resolution 2017-10; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2020, Mayor and Council determined that a small business grant program was in the best interest of the City and should take precedence over the Façade Improvement Program due to the impacts of COVID-19 on the small business community and via Resolution 2020-22, \$25,694 was reallocated from the Façade Improvement Program to a Small Business Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the application and award period for the Small Business Grant Program has passed and \$19,518 remains available; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that the Small Business Grant Program shall be closed and the Façade Improvement Program shall again take precedence for funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Augusta, in meeting duly assembled and by the authority thereof, that:

- 1. The Mayor and City Council do hereby redirect \$19,518 of the Small Business Grant Program to the Façade Improvement Program in the Capital Projects Fund.
- 2. The City Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to accept new façade grant applications and make grant award payments to both pre-existing and new façade grant projects in accordance established guidelines.
