Project Budget: \$3.93M

• Project Completion and Dedication: Target of Late Spring 2022.

- Building SF: Fire Apparatus Bays are approximately 5,000sf and rest of facility is 5,278sf for a total SF = 10,278sf.
- Property Size: 2.8 acres.
- Parking: <u>3ea double bays</u> for Fire Apparatus Equipment, **4ea** parking spaces for Public Safety employee parking, <u>7ea</u> for visitors, public or other staff parking.
- Bunk Rooms: This station will have **4ea Bunk Rooms** for Public Safety team members.
- Other Spaces: This station will also contain a full <u>Kitchen, Dining Room area, a Dayroom and Detox area</u>.
- Design Prototype: This Fire Station is the same prototype set up and layout as Fire Station #3. This
 prototype has worked well for the Public Safety team and allows for <u>cost savings</u> in the design
 process as well as <u>time savings</u> on the schedule.
