- The City of North Augusta operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, and national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act. Any person who believes he or she has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with the City of North Augusta, Federal Transit Administration (FTA), or Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).
