AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING & INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE KNOBCONE AVENUE SIDEWALK AND THE GREENEWAY EXTENSION – WOODSTONE TO MAYFIELD PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the City of North Augusta (City) applied for and was awarded Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) grants from the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) for the Knobcone Avenue Sidewalk and the Greeneway Extension – Woodstone to Mayfield Projects; and

WHEREAS, these projects will require the use of SCDOT certified technicians to perform Construction Engineering & Inspection (CE&I) services; and

WHEREAS, 4 firms responded to a "Request for Qualifications" and were reviewed by a committee consisting of Tom Zeaser, Director of Engineering & Public Works, Rick Meyer, Director of Parks & Recreation, Rachelle Moody, Assistant City Administrator, and Brian Maleck, Engineer I; and

WHEREAS, based upon the ranking of the firms, it has been determined that the following firm should be engaged by contract for the purposes of performing such services:

Infrastructure Consulting & Engineering (ICE); and

WHEREAS, the SCDOT has reviewed the City's solicitation, ranking, and fee negotiation process and has given its concurrence to the selection committee's recommendation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Augusta, South Carolina, in meeting duly assembled and by the authority thereof that, Infrastructure Consulting & Engineering shall be awarded the contract to perform CE&I services for both the Knobcone Avenue Sidewalk and the Greeneway Extension — Woodstone to Mayfield Projects.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funding for this contract shall be as follows:

Knobcone Avenue Sidewalk: SCDOT TAP Grant (LPA 02-21), 80%

Street Improvement Fund, Sidewalk/Curbing Program, 20%

Greeneway Extension: SCDOT TAP Grant (LPA 03-21), 80%

Sales Tax 3 Fund, Greeneway Extension, 20%

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE City Administrator is authorized to execute any documents required for the entering into of this contract.
