POWER HOUR

WHAT? Public Power Hour is a “*LISTENING*” opportunity for Council to hear citizens’ matters of interest or concerns. No action will be taken by Council during the Public Power Hour; instead, Council will review and consider comments from citizens.

WHO? Citizens who wish to speak to Council regarding items pertaining to city government which are not on the meeting agenda may sign up to participate.

WHEN? Public Power Hour is held before the first City Council meeting of each month at 5:30 PM in Council Chambers at the Municipal Center at 100 Georgia Avenue, North Augusta.

HOW? Citizens planning to speak at the Public Power Hour should contact the City Clerk before Noon on the Monday of the first City Council Meeting of each month. Be sure to leave a message at (803) 441-4202 or email the City Clerk at slamar@northaugusta.net. Messages and emails should include:

- speaker’s name
- subject to be addressed

Citizens who sign up to speak will be given first priority and be added to the Speaker’s List. If time allows, others who are present may be called upon to address Council. Comments should be held to five minutes, but the Mayor’s intent is to be respectful and flexible, if needed.
