The millage rate for the current fiscal year (2022) is 73.5. The proposed millage rate for fiscal year 2023 is 75.5. The proposed millage rate for fiscal year 2023 will collect an estimated \$11,076,374. The proposed 2023 budget includes rate increases to activities fees, residential sanitation and commercial sanitation. As with any budget year, there is potential for adopting additional increases during the public budget hearing scheduled for October 17, 2022.
