ORDER OF BUSINESS

The Municipal Election Commission meeting of April 27, 2023, having been duly publicized, was called to order by Chairperson Ben Watson at 11:00 a.m. in the Council Conference Room on the third floor of the Municipal Center.

Per Section 30-4-80(e) notice of the meeting was posted on the outside doors of the Municipal Center, the main bulletin board of the Municipal Center located on the first floor, and the City of North Augusta website.

Present were Commissioners Alphia Dunbar, Carleton Vaughn, and Ben Watson. Also, in attendance was Jamie Paul, City Clerk.

ITEM 3: Administration of Oath of Canvassers

Clerk Paul administered the Oath of Canvassers to the Municipal Election Commission Members.

ITEM 4: Provisional Ballot Hearing, if necessary

Clerk Paul provided the Aiken County Provisional Ballot list provided by the Aiken County Registration & Elections. She stated there are 2 Provisional ballots and 1 Failsafe Provisional ballot. She stated that Aiken County provided recommendations and requested that the MEC adjudicate the failsafe provisional ballot.

Discussion ensued on the failsafe provisional ballot and regular provisional ballots. The MEC concluded that the voter did follow the protocol from a regular general election by returning to their old precinct, however, should have been instructed to go to Aiken County to do the failsafe ballot. The MEC agreed that the failsafe provisional should be counted and agreed with the Aiken County recommendations on the two provisional ballots.

MEC did recognize that Ms. Angela Plexico Owen's did appear for the hearing as well.

It was moved by Commissionmember Vaughn, seconded by Commissionmember Dunbar, to accept Aiken County's recommendations on the two provisional ballots and reject Rose Richardson's provisional ballot and accept Genave Russo's provisional ballot and to approve Angela Plexico Owen's failsafe provisional ballot. Unanimously Approved. (See Attachment #4)

Clerk Paul stated that she will provide Aiken County Registration & Elections of motion after the meeting.

ITEM 5: Canvassing of Votes

MEC reviewed the unofficial numbers provided by Aiken County and Edgefield County. Clerk Paul explained that there was one failsafe ballot that was counted at Aiken County and was added the North Augusta totals spreadsheet. She added that the spreadsheet includes the Edgefield County's early vote totals too. (See Attachment #5)

MEC came to the consensus that the vote totals match the tape totals that was provided on election night and recognized the failsafe vote at Aiken County on election day.

ITEM 6: Certification of the Official Results for the April 25, 2023 Municipal General Election

MEC discussed the official results and requested that the Clerk update the letter to the City's Mayor to reflect the official results.

It was moved by Commissionmember Dunbar, seconded by Commissionmember Vaughn, to certify the Official Results for the April 25, 2023 Municipal General Election. Unanimously Approved. (See Attachment #6)

*In elections with all precincts open, a voter can go to their old precinct on time and vote a limited Failsafe Provisional ballot (only includes at-large, statewide, Federal offices - Not district specific) and do an address change. Or, the voter can complete an address change at our main office and vote a full Failsafe ballot. All precincts aren't open in municipal elections and a voter's old precinct may not be avaiable.

Therefore, only Emergency/Provisional ballots are provided in a municipal election and voters should come to our office and complete the address change.

However, it could be either the voter wasn't notified to come to our office or perhaps voter didn't want to make the drive as it is inconvenient.

Therefore, we recommend the North Augusta MEC adjudicate and make a judgement on acceptance of this ballot.

Be advised, though, that should the Board choose to accept the voters Provisional ballot, it will only record as a Provisional vote and not a Failsafe Provisional Vote on the final report.
