

Quercus michauxii Swamp Chestnut Oak

Hardiness: Zone 5-9

Foliage: 4-8" long, dark green, scallop margined

leaves, bronze red in the fall

Bark: Gray- brown and quite scaly

Shape: Rounded in outline

Mature Size: 80-100ft tall 80-100ft wide

Growth Rate: Fast

Shade: Full Sun; tolerates part shade

Adaptability: Needs adequate soil moisture and fertility for optimum growth and aesthetics, adaptable to less desirable growing conditions; spreading root systems tend to make it difficult to

preserve on construction sites.

Native Habitat: New Jersey, Delaware to Florida,

west to Indiana, Missouri and Texas

Uses: Noble tree for large-space landscapes
