

Acer palmatum 'Bloodgood' Bloodgood Japanese Maple



Category: Deciduous, broadleaf small tree

Hardiness: Zone 5b-8

Foliage: Opposite, simple, palmate; purple-red; greenish red leaves in hot summer conditions with Red fall color

Bark: Greenish red when young; light gray when mature

Shape: Globose, spreading

Mature Size: 30-50ft tall by 20-30ft wide

Growth Rate: Moderate

Shade: Part sun to shade

Adaptability: Moderate tolerance to urban environments; needs a shaded moist and well drained site.

Native Habitat: Japan, Korea, and Central China

Uses: Patio tree, containers, specimen and accent tree
