

Ulmus parvifolia 'UPMTF' Bosque Lacebark Elm



Category: Deciduous, broadleaf, large tree
Hardiness: Zone 5 to 9
Foliage: Medium to dark green
Bark: Smooth; olive to brownish gray when young; mature tree exfoliates puzzle-like bark exposing orange, tan, gray and brown patches
Winter color: yellow-orange to yellow-brown in the fall
Shape: Broad, oval
Mature Size: 60-65ft tall by 30-35ft wide
Growth Rate: Moderate to Fast
Shade: Full Sun to part shade
Adaptability: Very adaptable to different soil types; strong growth in poor planting environments
Native Habitat: Japan, Korea, Taiwan, Northern & Central China; cultivar of nursery origin
Uses: Street tree, parking lots, medians, lawn tree, shade tree
