

Pistacia chinensis Chinese Pistache



Category: Deciduous, broadleaf, large tree
Hardiness: Zone 6b-9
Foliage: Lustrous Dark green
Blooms: Shades of red, yellow, & brown blooms in the spring
Bark: Gray – brown that peels to expose salmon-red bark underneath; showy and attractive
Winter color: Shades of orange and red in the fall
Shape: Vase shaped, oval, round to irregular crown shape
Mature Size: 12-20ft tall by 12-20ft wide
Growth Rate: Moderate
Shade: Full Sun to part shade
Adaptability: Prefers moderately fertile and well-drained soil, but will grow in all soil types that are well drained
Native Habitat: Central & Western China
Uses: Outstanding specimen, shade or street tree
