Category: Deciduous, flowering large shrub, small tree

Hardiness: Zone 6-9

Foliage: Dark green

Blooms: White ,lightly fragrant flowers, strap-like

petals; April - May

Bark: Gray, and with maturity becomes ridged and

furrowed.

Winter color: yellow fall color and drop late often in

December in southern climates

Shape: Upright, rounded & spreading

Mature Size: 25-35ft tall by 25-35ft wide

Growth Rate: Slow to moderate

Shade: Full Sun to part shade

Adaptability: Very adaptable to soils and climatic

conditions over its hardiness range

Native Habitat: China

Uses: Specimen tree, small shade tree; a good

substitute for Cornus and Prunus
