


## Ulmus americana 'Jefferson' Jefferson American Elm



Native shade tree - own root. Expansive, vase-shaped canopy with arching limbs; dark green summer foliage. Adapted to a wide variety of soil conditions and ph. Selected from the Washington Mall by the National Park Service. Outstanding level of Dutch elm disease tolerance.

Hardiness: Zone 3 to 8

Foliage: Dark Green

Bark: Grayish brown with ridges and fissures.

Winter color: Yellow fall color

Shape: Upright Vase

Mature Size: 40-65' tall by 30-50' wide

Growth Rate: Fast

Shade: Full Sun to Part Shade

Adaptability: Tough tree once established

Native Habitat: Eastern Half of Northern America

Uses: As a specimen, urban areas, parks, and Street
