

## Taxodium distichum var. imbricarium, Pond Cypress



Category: Deciduous, coniferous, large tree

Hardiness: Zone 5 to 9

**Foliage:** soft appressed, rich green needles produce a foliage effect similar to that of a Cryptomeria japonica

**Bark:** Smooth; reddish brown fibers when young, ridges are narrow strips, ribbons and bands overlapping

Winter color: Orang-brown fall color, and drop off the

tree.

Shape: Pyramidal, columnar

Mature Size: Can reach 70 tall by 15-20' wide

**Growth Rate:** Slow

Shade: Full Sun to light shade

Adaptability: Good adaptability.

Native Habitat: Southern Swamps

Uses: Large parking lot islands, screenings and as a

shade tree.
