

Liriodendron tulipifera LTMTF ppaf

Prystal Tulip Poplar



Category: Large deciduous tree

Hardiness: Zone 5-8

Foliage: Dark green, foliage turning showy yellow in the fall

Bark: Smooth brownish green maturing to whitish gray; develops deep fissures and large ridges and plates, bark is easily damaged

Shape: Upright form with a central leader

Mature Size: 80-100ft tall 30-50ft wide

Growth Rate: Fast

Shade: Full Sun; part shade

Adaptability: Not tolerant of compacted or water logged soil or severe drought stress, need large space

Native Habitat: Eastern and Southern United States

Uses: Large specimen tree, lawn shade tree, street tree if planted in large planting strip, and naturalizing areas
