

**Gleditsiatriacanthus f. inermis 'Shademaster'**

**Shademaster Honeylocust**



<b>Category:</b> Deciduous, broadleaf tree
<b>Hardiness:</b> Zone 4-8
<b>Foliage:</b> Light to medium green
<b>Bark:</b> Smooth; young stems are greenish; older bark is gray-brown with deep, narrow furrows
<b>Shape:</b> Upright, very open with a thin crew
<b>Mature Size:</b> 30-50ft tall by 20-30ft wide
<b>Growth Rate:</b> Moderate to Fast
<b>Shade:</b> Full Sun to part shade
<b>Adaptability:</b> Moderate to high tolerance of urban pollution; adaptable to many soil types and light. Moderately tolerant of water logged soil, hot dry urban areas
<b>Native Habitat:</b> Eastern North America; cultivar of nursery origin
<b>Uses:</b> Naturalizing, borders, medians, street tree, urban plantings
