


Gleditsiatriacanthus f. inermis 'Shademaster'

Shademaster Honeylocust



Category: Deciduous, broadleaf tree

Hardiness: Zone 4-8

Foliage: Light to medium green

Bark: Smooth; young stems are greenish; older bark is gray-brown with deep, narrow furrows

Shape: Upright, very open with a thin crew

Mature Size: 30-50ft tall by 20-30ft wide

Growth Rate: Moderate to Fast

Shade: Full Sun to part shade

Adaptability: Moderate to high tolerance of urban pollution; adaptable to many soil types and light. Moderately tolerant of water logged soil, hot dry urban areas

Native Habitat: Eastern North America; cultivar of nursery origin

Uses: Naturalizing, borders, medians, street tree, urban plantings
