2011 CITY BUDGETADOPTED

The 2011 Consolidated Municipal Budget totaling \$27,544,483 was approved by the City Council on November 15, 2010. The City's mill levy for 2011 (2010 tax year) remains at 77.20 mills. Revenue from 68.69 mills will be collected for General Fund operating purposes and revenue from 8.51 mills will be applied to the City's Capital Projects Fund. The 2011 budget includes no tax or utility fee increases.

Tax Notices Mailed — IN JANUARY —

Tax notices on real and personal property and on merchants' inventory for the 2010 tax year will be mailed to property owners in January. Tax payments are due by May 1, 2011. For those property owners whose taxes are escrowed by a mortgage company, tax notices will be mailed directly to the mortgage company.

The City tax office is located in the Finance Department on the first floor of the Municipal Center, 100 Georgia Avenue. Questions about taxes should be directed to 803-441-4215.

2011 Business License Renewals DUE FEBRUARY 1

Business license renewal applications for calendar year 2011 will be mailed to current license holders during the last week of December. Completed applications must be returned to the City on or before February 1, 2011 to avoid a 10 percent delinquent payment penalty. The penalty will increase by an additional five percent each month until the application and fee are received.

License holders should carefully examine the information on the application to confirm its accuracy. Corrections or additions should be written directly on the application form. Once properly completed and signed, the application should be returned to the City with the correct fee. The turnaround time on a properly completed business license application is usually ten days or less.

The business license office is located on the first floor of the Municipal Center, 100 Georgia Avenue. Questions about business license renewals can be addressed by calling the City's Business License Clerk at 803-441-4214.

Winter Base Period for SEWER RATES IN EFFECT

The City of North Augusta uses a "Winter Base Sewer Rate System" for calculating sewer service charges. Three months of actual water usage are used to calculate sewer charges for the remaining nine months of the year. The three month base period covers the three water meter readings taken between December 10 and March 9. Water meter readings are based on the actual water consumed for the month preceding the reading.

Each utility customer is billed a sewer service charge based on actual water consumption during the three winter base months. The average consumption of these three months is then used for the remaining nine billing periods of the year. New customers with no winter base history are charged an amount equal to the average of all residential sewer customers. For more information about the Winter Base Period, please call 803-441-4212.

City Initiates ONLINE CONVENIENCE FEE

For several years, the City of North Augusta has offered the convenience and security of online payments for taxes, utilities and recreation program fees. To support the costs associated with this service, the City, beginning January 1, will charge \$3.00 for each payment made through the City's website <code>www.northaugusta.net</code>. The fee does not apply to face-to-face, electronic funds transfer or mailed transactions.
