ACCEPTING DONATION OF ADAPTIVE KAYAK LAUNCHER
ADDITION TO BOECKH PARK DOCK
FROM GEORGIA REHABILITATION INSTITUTE

WHEREAS, the City of North Augusta accepts this generous donation and accepts desired location for the adaptive kayak launcher to the Boeckh Park Dock.

WHEREAS, the City of North Augusta by accepting this donation will become the owner of the adaptive kayak launcher and will be responsible for the maintenance of this addition to the Boeckh Park Dock or relocation/removal of the addition should it become necessary.
