## Residential Yard Waste Collection

## Yard Waste in the Gutter, Street, or Storm Drainage



Yard waste in the gutter, street, or drainage system can cause flooding and infrastructure damage by clogging storm drains.

Yard Waste must be placed behind the curb on the home owner's property in neatly separated piles such as tree trimmings, grass clippings, hedge clippings, leaves, appliances, and furniture shall be collected at the same location as that designated for garbage collection.

In no event shall trash be placed in the gutter, street, or storm drainage system. Be sure to keep at least three feet from obstructions and/or hazards (fire hydrants, water meters, vehicles, power/cable lines and roll carts).

Individual trash items shall not exceed four (4) feet in diameter, ten (10) feet in length, or two hundred (200) pounds in weight. The quantity of pickup may be limited by the city.

Yard Waste bags are permitted and can be placed curbside for collection and should not exceed 50 pounds per bag.

## **Yard Waste from Contracted Work**

"Refuse generated by contractors or property owners for new construction or remodeling, landscaping companies, yard crews, and tree trimming/removal companies shall be removed by the companies or property owners and shall not be the responsibility of the city."
