## RESOLUTION NO. 2024-38 AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NORTH AUGUSTA TO AMEND A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT WITH TISCHLERBISE, INC., TO PERFORM ADDITIONAL SERVICES FOR CREATION OF AN IMPACT FEE STRUCTURE AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR PARKS AND RECREATION

WHEREAS, the City of North Augusta retained the services of TischlerBise, Inc. to provide services related to the evaluation and design of an Impact Fee and Capital Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, City Council approved the engineering services contract by Resolution No. 2023-51 to conduct studies required for the adoption of an impact fee ordinance for Transportation, Water, Sewer, and Storm Water which set aside \$97,340 in SLFRF funds; and

WHEREAS, City Council has determined that studies required for the possible adoption of an impact fee ordinance for Parks and Recreation is desired.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of North Augusta, South Carolina, in meeting duly assembled and by the authority thereof, that:

- 1. The Council authorizes the City Administrator to enter into an amended professional engineering services contract with TischlerBise, Inc. to provide services to create an Impact Fee structure and a Capital Improvement Plan that will include Parks and Recreation.
- 2. The Council authorizes the City Administrator to finalize and execute any contracts in regards to the conduct studies required for the adoption of an impact fee ordinance for Transportation, Water, Sewer, Storm Water, and Parks and Recreation.
- 3. Expenditures of an additional \$14,500 from SLFRF funds, are approved to conduct studies required for the possible adoption of an impact fee ordinance for Parks and Recreation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administrator is authorized to execute such documents as necessary to enter into said amended contract for a total not to exceed \$111,840.
