The following are among the topics for discussion and review:

ITEM 1. CITY COUNCIL AGENDA: Items on the May 2, 2016 Council Agenda – Council Discussion

At this time, any questions related to the agenda scheduled for tonight's meeting may be discussed.

ITEM 2. PARKS, RECREATION, & TOURISM: Presentation on Gym Additions by Studio 3 & Craig, Gaulden, Davis Architects

Representatives from Studio 3 & Craig, Gaulden, Davis Architects will be present to address Mayor and Council on the recommended location of the proposed gym additions.

ITEM 3. MATERIAL RECOVERY FACILITY: Update from Director of Public Utilities, James Sutton

Dear Todd:

At our March 21st CTC work session meeting, the committee was informed by SCDOT of a significant increase in the cost of the intersection improvements at Old Edgefield Road and LeCompte Ave. It is of utmost concern that this project is completed, but, due to the updated cost of the project being 3x the original estimate, (requiring an additional \$361,566 from the CTC) we are concerned that we will not be able to fulfill our commitment to this project.

The CTC would like to propose that the City of North Augusta consider appropriating their 2016-2017 annual 10% allocation toward this project since this intersection is located within the city limits of North Augusta.

We have a work session meeting scheduled for Monday, April 25th at 6:00 p.m. We would appreciate a response from you prior to our meeting we can include this on our agenda for consideration.
