ITEM 2. FINANCE: South Carolina Public Employee Benefit Authority Increase – Council Update

The South Carolina Public Employee Benefit Authority approved a .5% increase in both employee and employer contribution rates for the SC Retirement System and the Police Officers Retirement System. Contributions are expected to increase effective July 1, 2016. City Administrator, Todd Glover, and Director of Finance, Cammie Hayes, will update Mayor and Council on the budget impact of this increase.
