Brick Pond Park FISHING POLICY

The City of North Augusta Ponds may be fished according to the following Fish Policy and Guidelines. North Augusta Public Safety Department will have jurisdiction over these areas and enforce these polices. Fishing at <u>West Pond (pond with dock) is allowed</u> at Brick Pond Park at this time (see map next page). All other ponds within the park are off limits to fishing.

- 1. The City of North Augusta is not responsible for users. Users Assume "All Risk" while fishing in City owned ponds.
- 2. Fishing areas are predetermined (see note above). Users beyond the designated areas are subject to forfeiture of Fishing Permit and Trespass Notice.
- 3. A Valid City of North Augusta Fishing Permit is required and must be in the possession of the user. Any user over the age of 16 must also possess a valid South Carolina Fishing License. City Permits may be purchased at the Riverview Park Activities Center, 100 Riverview Park Drive. Mon – Sat 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. and Sunday 1:30 p.m. to 5 p.m. (803) 441-4311
- 4. City of North Augusta Fishing Annual Permit fee is as follows:

5. NO GASOLINE POWERED MOTOR BOATS ARE PERMITTED. (Row boats, canoes, paddle boats, and small electric trolling motors ok)

- 6. Non-game fishing devices are prohibited in city owned ponds: (traps, trot lines, jugs, nets, spears, or other non-game fishing devices) <u>Do not attempt to harass, hunt, capture, wound or kill</u> <u>alligators or turtles</u>.
- 7. Hours for Fishing: 30 minutes before Legal Dawn until 30 minutes before Legal Sunset.
- 8. No minnows are permitted.
- 9. No fire arms or hunting is permitted.
- 10. No alcoholic beverages or drugs are permitted.
- **11.** A Catch and Release Program is in effect on City Ponds until Further Notice.
- 12. No littering is permitted. Carry out what you carry in.
- 13. No FEEDING of any wildlife (other than fishing).
- 14. All pond visitors must remain out of the water (i.e., no swimming, wading, water sports, or standing in any of the ponds).
