PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE CITY OF NORTH AUGUSTA, SOUTH CAROLINA

The North Augusta City Council has scheduled a Public Hearing for Monday, September 18, 2017 at 7:00 pm. Such Public Hearing shall take place immediately preceding the regularly scheduled City Council Meeting. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to receive public comments on a proposed ordinance that would abandon a platted, but unopened, unimproved right-of-way within the City.

The specific property is described as follows:

A ± 30 foot undeveloped road commencing at a point ± 233.52 feet north of the intersection of Five Notch Road and Georgia Avenue, extending westward a distance of ± 200 feet. Said property is identified as a ± 30 foot undeveloped road on a plat of K. L. Wise, surveyor, dated August 20, 1970. Said strip of land is also shown on a plat prepared for Joseph Vignati by Carr and Associates dated December 30, 2016 and recorded in the Office of the RMC for Aiken County, South Carolina in Plat Book 60 at Page 6. Said undeveloped roadway has a width of ± 30 feet for a majority of its length. However, the width is reduced in a tapering manner for the final ± 46 feet.
